Please note: All competitors with letters next to their registration number should report to the Race Office prior to the first Team Captain's meeting or they will not be allowed to start in a race.

All Competitors marked "C", will be required to provide proof of racing competence, prior to being admitted to a race. Suitable evidence may include evidence of performance in other races or a Coach's certificate. Competitors marked with a "***" need to come to the Race Office once they arrive in resort.

We would be extremely grateful if each Club or Individual could provide us with a list of their Racers, along with a contact number/details for themselves. SPEED TRAINING

Any Teams wishing to share a Super G training piste in Oga should speak to Pasquale at the Bormio Lift Pass Office on Bormio 2000, or discuss lane sharing at the Team Captain's Meetings with the other coaches.

MINI'S RACES

The TD forum decided that for all Mini Races, competitors must not be younger than maximum 4 years below CH1 (for 2011, born 2000, 2001, 2002 & 2003) registration with any Home Nation Governing Body is recommended, and if this is their first year it is free with Snowsport England and Snowsport Wales but it is not compulsory. However, if the racer does not hold a valid registration, he/she will have to submit a completed Athletes Declaration & confirmation of Liability Insurance covering racing to the race office prior to racing.

Note: Mini racers are not permitted to race in cat suits.

CHILDREN'S START ORDER

1. All children's races in the 2011 Alpine Race Calendar must follow the BCR.
2. Both Slalom and GS must be run as two separate single run races (GS may be only a single race if circumstances, e.g force majeure, preclude running two).
3. Start order to be based on the seeding system, graded ability levels.
4. CH1 & CH2 must be drawn separately.
5. Category order to be agreed by the Jury and announced at the Team Captain's Meeting. It will remain the same for both races.
6. Each race to count separately for seed points, but championship medals to be awarded on aggregate times.
7. The Start Order to be determined by a draw of the top group, the remainder of seeded athletes in seed point order, followed by a draw of non-seeded racers. The second run will be drawn in reverse order.
8. The Super-G to stay as per current BCR, the Jury to decide the running order of the categories at the Team Captain's Meeting.

ACCREDITATION

Coaches, photographers, or other personnel entering the race piste during course setting, training, inspection or racing must be accredited by the Organizing Committee. All coaches and team managers representing athletes at the Team Captain's meetings must similarly be accredited. Application forms can be downloaded from www.britski.org and www.englishalpinechamps.org.uk Clubs should send a list of team managers/coaches requiring accreditation together with completed forms to the Race Secretary – andrea@buttermountain.com no later than Friday 18th February 2011. Volunteer officials are automatically accredited on the days when they volunteer.

LATE ENTRIES

The Male FIS SL & FIS GS races are full.

The Organising Committee will consider late entries in all other races received by 23.00h on Friday 11th February 2011 for the race on Sunday 20th February, and for subsequent races, no later than 24 hours before the Team Captain's Meeting for the race concerned. Competitors must meet the published entry criteria. Decisions on acceptance will be available from Thursday 17th February for entries received by that date and at the relevant Team Captain's Meeting for entries considered in resort.

LATE ENTRIES WILL INCUR A SURCHARGE OF £20.00 PER RACE and be subject to FIS and British Competition rules.

CANCELLATION OF CHAMPIONSHIPS

If snow or other conditions cause the cancellation of these Championships prior to the event, details will be published on www.englishalpinechamps.org.uk and www.britski.org by Thursday 17th February 2011.

REFUNDS

Due to the enormous cost of organizing these Championships, there will be no refund of race entry fee made available after your race entry has been accepted even if one or more races are cancelled.

These are awarded to the English male/female racer with the best combined results from Slalom, GS, and Super G. This will be calculated as per BCR BK IV. 5.1.3.

NOMINATION OF CLUB

All racers who have listed only one Club when registering with their Governing Body will automatically be listed to represent this Club.

All racers who have nominated a Club for snow races when registering with their Governing Body will automatically be listed to represent this Club.

The British Championships rules state that for team competitions, "Competitors shall compete for their first named club, as shown on the current BASS list. Except in the most exceptional circumstances and with the prior approval of the Organizing Committee, no changes shall be allowed in the resort."

Racers' Clubs stated on the acceptance list are as recorded on their HNGB databases.

PLEASE REMEMBER

Entry to FIS races are subject to National Quotas. The Organizing Committee can only confirm the acceptance at the first Team Captain's Meeting on 19/02/11 when foreign entries are known.
